## **Intergalactic Gaming Cookies Policy**

#### 01 April 2020

Intergalactic Gaming ("**IG**") uses and allows certain other companies to set cookies on the 'Intergalactic Gaming' platform (currently available at <u>www.iggalaxy.com</u>, the "**Platform**").

### What are cookies?

Cookies are small data files that contain a string of characters. Our servers, or those of a partner we work with, may send your device a cookie when you visit the Platform.

Cookies help us to improve the Platform and to deliver a better and more personalised service, for instance by storing information about your preferences and allowing us to recognise you when you return to the Platform.

### The Platform uses the following types of cookies:

**Strictly Necessary Cookies**: These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the Platform and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the Platform. Without these cookies, services like enabling appropriate content based your type of device cannot be provided.

**Performance Cookies**: These cookies collect information about how visitors use the Platform, for instance which pages visitors go to most often, and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies don't collect information that identifies a visitor. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. It is only used to improve how the Platform works.

**Functionality Cookies**: These cookies allow the Platform to remember choices you make (such as your language or the region you are in) and provide enhanced, more personal features. These cookies can also be used to remember changes you have made to text size, fonts and other parts of web pages that you can customise. They may also be used to provide services you have asked for such as watching a video or commenting on a blog. The information these cookies collect may be anonymised and they cannot track your browsing activity on other websites.

**Social Media Cookies**: These cookies allow you to share what you've been doing on the Platform on social media such as Facebook and Twitter. This information may be linked to targeting/advertising activities.

**Targeting Cookies:** These cookies are used to deliver advertising more relevant to you and your interests. They are also used to limit the number of times you see an advertisement as well as help measure the effectiveness of the advertising campaigns.[They are usually placed by advertising networks with our permission.] They remember that you have visited a website and this information is shared with other organisations such as advertisers. For example, we use third party companies such as 'Google Adsense' to provide you with more personalised adverts when visiting other websites.
